To whom it may concern,

I am very concerned about the rapid growth of housing in Rugby which is not being matched by infrastructure. Over a thousand houses are being built each year and we have had no new GP surgeries and no new roads. Open space is being taken away for development eg at Oakfields Park and new green space is not being added to match the pace of development. Regarding Q33 I am not in favour of any new land being set aside for housing until the infrastructure has caught up. I am particularly concerned that the Rainsbrook Valley - listed as South of Hillmorton - should not be developed. The slope leading up to Hillmorton can be seen for miles around and this landscape should continue to be protected as a green space available to all. Hopefully after your operation you will fully recover and you can go onto the RBC website and work through some more of the questions before the 2 February. However even the short response shown above will let them know you care and put you on their roll for future consultations.
