

## **South West Rugby Design Code Supplementary Planning Document Adoption Statement**

In accordance with Regulation 11 of the Town and Country Planning Regulations (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) notice is hereby given that Rugby Borough Council adopted the South West Rugby Design Code Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 9 July 2025.

A number of modifications were made to the public consultation version SPD in accordance with Section 23(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. These are set out in the 'South West Rugby Design Code SPD Consultation Statement'.

In addition, minor corrections and amendments to the version of the SPD presented to Cabinet on 24 June 2025 have been incorporated into the adopted SPD. These changes were made pursuant to the delegated authority to make such amendments given by Council on 9 July 2025.
