Fit and Proper Person Declaration

IMPORTANT NOTES

When deciding whether a licence applicant is a 'fit and proper person' the Local Authority must have regard, among other things, to evidence which shows that the applicant or any person associated or formally associated with him/her, whether personally or on a work basis is a fit and proper person.

To do this we must have regard to matters laid down in legislation (Housing Act 2004 section 66). These questions are asked in order to enable us to satisfy this legal requirement.

In making a decision on whether or not to grant a licence on the basis of information given in this section, each case will be considered on its merits. That is, minor infringements that happened a long time ago will not necessarily mean that a licence will be refused. Conversely recent serious infringements relating directly to the business of running and managing an HMO may well imply to the Council that an applicant or manager is not a fit and proper person. There are appeal provisions if you are aggrieved by the Council's determination.

In addition please note:

- 1. The questions should be answered in the name of the individual or company who has applied for the licence.
- 2. In the case of a limited company or partnership, offences attributed to both the company and directors or partners must be included.
- 3. In answering questions concerning previous convictions, etc., details should be given in respect of all properties owned or managed by the applicant, whether in Rugby or in other Local Authority areas.
- 4. The Council will treat all responses received in the strictest confidence.
