RUGBY AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA (NITROGEN DIOXIDE)

ORDER 2004

SECTION 83(1) ENVIRONMENT ACT 1995

ORDER DESIGNATING AN AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA

Whereas the Rugby Borough Council ("the Council") is satisfied that as a result of its air quality review and assessment dated June 2004, the air quality objective for Nitrogen Dioxide is not likely to be achieved by 31 December 2005 (being the relevant period described by the Air Quality Regulations 1997) in the area described in the schedule below, for reasons both of the current and projected exceedence of the objective.

Now therefore the Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order.

IT IS HEREBY OREDERED THAT: -

1. The area shown outlined in red on the attached map which forms part of this Order. And described in the schedule below, shall be designated as an Air Quality Management Area, to be known as Rugby Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide).
2. That the Air Quality Management Area be specific to Nitrogen Dioxide only.
3. That the Order be cited as "Rugby Borough Council Rugby Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide) Order 2004".
4. The Order shall come into force on 16th December 2004, and shall remain in force until varied or revoked by subsequent Order.

SCHEDULE

The area of Rugby bounded by the southern boundary with Daventry District Council, A5, M6, minor roads to the west of Long Lawford, A45 and M45.
