## Rugby Borough Council Community Infrastructure Levy Draft Charging Schedule Consultation

We welcome the opportunity to comment on Rugby Borough Council's Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Draft Charging Schedule. We understand that the purpose of this document is to set out the draft charges on new developments that local planning authorities can choose to introduce with charges dependent upon the scale and location of the developments.

National Highways has been appointed by the Secretary of State for Transport as strategic highway company under the provisions of the Infrastructure Act 2015 and is the highway authority, traffic authority and street authority for the Strategic Road Network (SRN). It is our role to maintain the safe and efficient operation of the SRN whilst acting as a delivery partner to national economic growth. In relation to this consultation, our principal interest is in safeguarding the operation of the M6, M45, and A5 which all route through and near to the area.

The document sets out the approach that will be adopted by Rugby Borough Council when setting and implementing the CIL.

We welcome Draft Charging Schedule, however have limited further comments to provide other than to encourage communications in relation to any proposed changes or developments on the SRN. We trust that the above is useful in the progression of the Rugby Borough Council Community Infrastructure Levy.
