Good afternoon,

Newton and Biggin Parish Council wish to submit the following consultation response:

The proportion of any CIL to be paid to Parish Councils remains in accordance with statutory requirements and as a result the Parish Council has no comments to make on this point.

It is appreciated that RBC has sought advice from BNP Paribas on the viability of the CIL charges and is satisfied that they will not act as a disincentive to development. However, dependent upon the location and size of a residential development, it would appear that a CIL payment in excess of £300,000 per ha could be levied. It is RBC's assumption that rather than being added to house prices this will result in reduced land values. This may, or may not be correct (only time will tell) but if it does come off land value, might it not lead to landowners deciding not to release land for development at the present time? Either way, now may not be the best time to introduce a substantial additional cost on development given the current focus on maximising house building and market fragility.
