


## DECISION UNDER DELEGATED POWERS

Subject	Appointment of contractor to provide, deliver and install essential white goods.
Officer Requesting Decision	Communities & Projects Manager
Officer Making the Decision	Chief Officer Communities & Homes
Authority for Decision	Delegated authority under paragraph 2.5 (i) of Part 2B of Rugby Borough Council's Constitution – Each Chief Officer is authorised to invite and accept tenders or quotation for contracts, subject to contract standing orders, financial standing orders, financial regulations and financial instructions,
Recommendation	To appoint AO to provide, deliver and install essential white goods (fridge-freezers/ovens/washing machines) for those with recent experience of homelessness and enter into a contract for the same. This is the RBC White Goods Project funded by UKSPF
Alternatives considered and rejected	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To appoint an alternative contractor to provide, deliver &amp; install the white goods.</li> <li>2. To bulk purchase white goods, store them and have them delivered and installed by RBC staff/PRS</li> <li>3. To not deliver the project and give the available funding back to Govt or to another eligible project at RBC</li> </ol>
Decision	Approve
Reason	AO have an excellent track record of delivering services to housing providers and charities, they have a team dedicated to delivering this part of their work.

	They can deliver the project from start to finish following referral of the tenant/customer.  They can deliver the project within the timescales required.
