Better Defence Estate Strategy (published Nov 2016) identifies Gamecock Barracks. Gamecock Barracks makes a positive contribution to the local economy. NPPF Para 97 requires planning policies to take into account wider security and defence requirements. Would like to see section of the NDP about the history of the site, support for its continuing presence and references in principle support for further development, subject to green belt constraints. Policy S1- Should reference green belt designation Community Action T5- Public Transport. MOD happy with action for improved bus services. MOD happy to work
